We teach how to work safely in the dangerous field and get efficient results for your labor. When you graduate from this program you will be vastly more capable than when you started. Beginners are welcome. Expect clear direction and lots of focused work. Expect to learn mountains of information. You must be between 20 to 60 years old to apply. This work-study is free from cash exchange. Room and boarding fees may be asked, depending on your experience level. Graduates may be welcomed to stay on longer at this educational work camp.
