You will rub sticks together and create fire! Magnificent elation and personal empowerment usually come with this initiation toward touching the prehistory of your ancestors. Harvest this skill and carry it with you forever. David Haas, your instructor, coach, and guide is a marvelous, sensitive teacher. He is truly impassioned about getting you to succeed in this experience. This ancient art of bringing fire out of friction is not overrated. Try your hand at this grounding instruction. Learn the history of fire from its primitive roots. We will explore several matchless techniques as well as making equipment and preparing your tools. We will gather materials in the wild while enjoying the inspiring retreat aspect of the preserve. Bow drill, hand drill, flint and steel, and other methods are all on tap. \* Bringing your own pocket knife would be useful, but is not required. Just bring your interest - we will supply everything else.
