# SPOON CARVING WORKSHOP WITH EUSTACE CONWAY

This is an old time, "go out and get the tree - and end up with a spoon," kind of workshop. You will harvest a good time, a lot of wood shavings, and a profound shift in understanding simple hand tools, wood working techniques, and an earlier economic perspective and appreciation. This workshop is for beginners of woodcarving and for more experienced carvers who want to focus in on this one product... the spoon. Although the process and that that it encompasses is more important to us as teachers, you will take home the product of a spoon and or several spoons made by you from fresh cherry wood.

All materials are provided, although you are encouraged to bring a pocketknife or carving knife if you have one. We will learn the usage of such tools as the cross cut saw, axe, sledge hammer & wedges, maul, shaving horse, drawknife, gouge, scrape and more.

Eustace Conway, instructor for this venture back in time will help you open new doors in your understanding of wood, tools, history, and yourself! Eustace has been carving spoons and using them for over 30 years. An impassioned, grassroots environmental activist, he finds that putting your hands on the materials yourself and relating directly to the earth through this "hands on Spoons" approach is invaluable. Real experience equals real results.
